CURRENCY

The currency of Ireland is the Euro (EUR).

As of May 9, 2018:

€1 EUR = \$1.19 USD

\$1 USD = €0.84 EUR

The euro is divided into 100 cents.

Dublin's international airport is [Dublin Airport](#) and the airport code is DUB. **Be aware flights departing the US arrive Dublin the following day.** Return flights arrive the US the same day as departure.

NOTE: If you do not stay at the Colloquium Headquarters Hotel under the Colloquium group rate, there will be an additional Non-Conference Hotel Fee of US \$150 per person automatically charged on Monday, November 12, 2018, to the same credit card used to pay for registration.

KEY DISTANCES

Note the Colloquium is being held northwest of Dublin and NOT in downtown Dublin.

Dublin Airport to Dunboyne Castle Hotel and Spa: Dunboyne Castle Hotel is 14 miles west of Dublin Airport

Dublin Airport to Downtown Dublin: Downtown Dublin is seven miles south of Dublin Airport

Downtown Dublin to Dunboyne Castle Hotel: The Dunboyne Castle Hotel and Spa is 16 miles northwest of downtown Dublin



TRANSPORTATION

Rental cars

- Cars in Ireland are driven on the left side of the road
- If you are renting a car, we recommend verifying the type of insurance coverage you have and to also rent a car with an automatic transmission as most rental cars in Ireland are manual transmissions
- Small cars are the norm in Ireland and due to the narrow width of many roads, small cars are recommended

Public Transportation

To get from the airport to the hotel by public transportation, you must first go into downtown Dublin and connect to either a bus or train. Total travel time via public transportation is one hour and 30 minutes.

When taking public transportation to Dunboyne Castle, the closest stop is a half mile from the hotel.

TAXI

Airport-Dunboyne Castle Hotel: €35-45 (30 minutes)

Airport-Downtown: €25-35 (20-30 minutes)

Downtown-Dunboyne Castle: €40-50 (30 minutes)

- Due to traffic, travel time from the airport to downtown can vary greatly, thereby significantly increasing the total fare
- **Uber does operate in Ireland**
- Another option is www.ie.mytaxi.com

BUS & TRAIN

- The [AirLink](#) bus is an express bus that costs €7 EUR for a one-way ticket and €12 EUR for a round-trip ticket from the airport to downtown Dublin (20 minutes)
- The [AirCoach](#) is another option that serves different areas of Dublin than the AirLink bus
- [Public buses](#) have more stops than express buses but costs €2.5 EUR (40 minutes)
- From downtown, you can reach the Dunboyne Castle Hotel on the #70 Dublin bus or by train
- There are several all-day Dublin bus pass options, some which include the AirLink service
